We are wrapping up the construction of our first donated greenhouse, what a great way to end this amazing year of business! The Montessori Children's School of San Luis Obispo located at 4200 South



Higuera Street will be the home of our first donated greenhouse to a children's organization. At A Place to Grow we believe that children need to connect with our earth through planting seeds and watching them grow. The children at the Montessori Children's School of San Luis Obispo plan to plant tomato seeds and once they have grown to seedlings, they will sell them to fund their Art Program.

We have been very busy in October and November! We installed a greenhouse in Paso Robles, what a truly sacred space it is.

We also installed a "Catio" -a name coined by our client for the unique outdoor space we created for her cat, Sir Hilary. Needless to say, he loves his space!

## Unique Materials

We have many unique materials that we are sourcing from all over San Luis Obispo County and continue to source from Box Kite Barn Yard. We still have access to beautiful 1" x 6" French oak flavor sticks used in the processing of bulk red wine in stainless steel tanks. These flavor sticks retain the color of the red wine that they flavor, at this time the white wine sticks have sold out, however, we still have access to the red wine flavor sticks at this time. This picture shows them in one of our recent greenhouses.

We also have some old redwood fence boards from Vandenberg Air Force Base that are almost 1" thick and truly have the look and feel of barn wood yet are priced lower than barn wood! These are featured in the "Catio" that we just installed.

We continue to have access to beautiful urban forested lumber. What is "urban forested lumber" you may ask? This is lumber milled from trees that have fallen on their own or trees that an arborist has determined must be removed. We have this lumber milled specifically for us to use in our structures.


