Featured Structure: Sage Nursery Shed

This delightful shed has been located at Sage Ecological nursery for the past three years where it has functioned as their cut flower kiosk. Unfortunately, Sage closed their doors of their nursery on October 31, 2016. This amazing shed sold immediately and is now located right on the bay

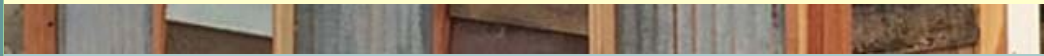


in Baywood Park! The view is incredible and the shed looks like it has always been there.

This shed tells an interesting story based on the materials used to build it. The two redwood doors hung horizontally as windows and the rear window all came from a home in San Luis Obispo that was designed and built in the 1960's by an architecture graduate from Cal Poly. These are truly unique and

one of a kind! The material above the doors/windows is from a retaining wall made from old growth redwood murch from Atascadero. The exterior looks gray and weathered, but just underneath is a beautiful grain and all the resilience that is contained in the redwood itself. The barn wood on either side of the rear window came from a 100 year old barn in Edna Valley. The sheet metal above the rear window is scrap from the railroad center re-construction in San Luis Obispo after the fire destroyed the original buildings. The metal corrugated roof material came from an old farmhouse in Nipomo.

This spectacular shed is really a show stopper! This was truly a team approach as [Pacific Coast Lumber](#) milled the wood from a Cambria Monterey pine tree. The tree was brought to us by Cal Fire as part of a program where they wish to carbon sequester as much as possible the dead and dying trees in Cambria. By milling the wood into a

tangible end user product, it keeps the carbon in the wood, where chipping it or burning it would release the carbon and be harmful to our environment.



This shed features a barn door in the front and a vintage door as a drop down bar. The windows came from a beloved long time San Luis Obispo resident, Dr. Divincenzo, his beautiful spirit lives on in this shed! This shed measures approximately 9' x 9' with a 3' porch overhang.

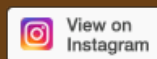
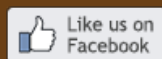
